Candidates will be shortlisted based on their application, which must include details of their sporting achievements.

Candidates should complete the scholarship application form with either a written application or a presentation detailing the following:

- What sports you play

- List of your sporting achievements
- Why you feel you should be considered for a sports scholarship.
- Testimonials from teachers /club coaches should also be provided at this stage and should be included with your presentation/document.

The supporting documents must be submitted with your scholarship form.

The candidate should currently be fully committed to their club teams and be competing at a representative level in at least one of our major sports - Cricket, Football, Hockey, Netball. Other sports will be considered on an individual basis.

Candidates must be able to demonstrate a talent and passion for their chosen sport and will be expected to be a role model to others, inspiring them through their own positive behavior and determination to improve.

The successful candidates will be expected to be actively involved in the wider sporting life of the school and to commit fully to all training sessions and matches.
